

KS5 Retention Report from IDSR 2021

Learners are counted in the retained measure if they have completed all learning activities for their main aim. Learners are counted in the retained for a second year measure if they have returned to the same provider for a second year of study and are retained in their second year.

The IDSR shows the number of learners who are eligible for each measure and, in square brackets, the number of learners who were not retained.

Definitions:

Retained – Students who complete their main programme of study. Introduced in 2016.

Retained for second year (level 3 only) – Students who return and complete a second year, completing an aim of size equivalent to at least one A level. Introduced in 2017.

Retained and assessed – Students who complete their main programme of study and are assessed at the end of their course. Introduced in 2017.
